Re: Lifting of Member Disenrollment Restrictions – COVID-19

The NYS Department of Health (Department) is issuing this notification to inform Health Homes that member disenrollment restrictions issued in response to the COVID-19 State of Emergency are being lifted, *effectively immediately*. Please refer to the following COVID-19 *Health Home Frequently Asked Questions* issued by the Department on March 26, 2020 (revised April 9, 2020) for guidance related to member disenrollment:

Health Homes should identify members for whom disenrollment is appropriate, for example: members who no longer need or want HHCM services, and members disengaged from HHCM services and cannot be found, as described in Health Home policy, *Member Disenrollment From the Health Home Program HH0007*:

The Department will be evaluating Health Home data and working with Health Homes individually to obtain a better understanding of who their members are that fall in the LOW category to determine if they are appropriate to step-down toward disenrollment.
